The coconut mosaic is produced from a coconut shell.

The shell is splitted, dried under the sun, sorted, polished, toned with natural dyes and varnished.

The wood which is handled in a special way is used for marquetry production. The mosaic is produced from such fine woods as mahogany, avocado and jackfruit.

The mosaic is handworked at all times of production.





Lateral sections of a





# MOSAIC CUTTING



For cutting of mosaic at the place of joint break it along the joint on the edge of a table. Then cut a glue base with a sharp utility knife.



For cutting of mosaic not at the place of joint (along a coconut cell) use an angle grinder, electrical fret saw or an arm-saw.

# MOSAIC MONTAGE

For gluing on the coconut mosaic we recommend to use the joint glue Cosca or a glue on a silicone base of another producers.

It is necessary to put the glue in a net form on the back parts of mosaic.



Press a panel with glue to the surface. It is necessary to press the panels marry in to each other.

# MOSAIC MONTAGE



The panels are plastic and can be glued to a radial surface.



After drying up of the glue you need to use a wax crayon Cosca to hide the joints between panels.
